To qualify to take the exam at ISU, you must:

- Have graduated from an accredited college or university with a degree in geology, engineering geology, or a related geological science; OR you must have successfully completed 30 semester hours (45 quarter hours) of courses in physical and historical geology, mineralogy, structural geology, igneous and metamorphic petrology, stratigraphy and sedimentation, field geology, hydrogeology, economic geology, geochemistry, paleontology, environmental geology, engineering geology, geomorphology, or geophysics, or their equivalent as determined by ISU.
- Currently enrolled students may provide unofficial transcripts and the contact information of an active professor in their department.
- Graduates must provide an official transcript documenting their undergraduate degree in geology, engineering geology, or a related geological science from an accredited college or university.
